

Members are required to complete and report their professional development requirements by the June 30<sup>th</sup> reporting deadline of the two-year reporting period. Further, new members are required to complete the AAA mandatory courses by the corresponding deadline. Members who are non-compliant on July 1st will be assessed a \$750.00 Professional Development Arrears Fee and will be referred to the Registrar who, in turn, will issue a Notice of Intent to Cancel Registration. The Notice will stipulate the time period for paying the arrears fee and the time period for completing the outstanding Professional Development requirements. Failure to pay the invoice and/or complete the outstanding professional development requirements will result in cancellation of membership. This is in keeping with Section 27(1) of the Architects Act.

Members designating a primary jurisdiction outside Alberta for reporting their professional development must comply with the requirements of that primary jurisdiction. Non-compliance with the primary jurisdiction will mean that the member is non-compliant with the AAA and will be subject to the AAA arrears fee and Notice of Intent to Cancel Registration.
