Primary Jurisdiction Policy

Architects with a principal practice/residence outside Alberta can designate the jurisdiction of their home province as their primary jurisdiction for purposes of PD reporting. Follow these steps prior to the PD reporting period deadline:

- Sign in to our website
- Select the tab 'My AAA Account' > 'My PD Transcript'
- Complete the online PD Declaration, including the primary jurisdiction field
- Report all learning activities to the selected primary jurisdiction
- Complete AAA mandatory courses – as outlined in the tables above.
