

Mentor Confirmation

Interns, students and syllabus students are required to select a mentor before they begin recording experience in their respective logbooks. For intern architects and students enrolled in the last year of their architecture program, this is the Canadian Experience Record Book (CERB). The mentor acts as a professional advisor who meets regularly with the intern or student to review progress in obtaining necessary experience and to offer constructive advice.

For architectural students and intern architects, the mentor must be a Registered Architect or a Retired Architect in good standing.

For intern interior designers, the mentor may be a Registered Architect, Licensed Interior Designer or Retired Architect in good standing.
